Adrienne Pickering is a graduate of QUT, and has an extensive career spanning across stage and screen. She is perhaps best known for starring opposite Richard Roxburgh in the highly acclaimed Logie winning ABC series, *Rake*.

Adrienne's film work includes Neil Armfield's *Candy*, *She Was Quiet*, *Pug*, and *Final Call*, as well as the US productions *Shutter for Fox*, and the role of Alison in the Alex Proyas film, *Knowing* with Nicholas Cage for Summit Entertainment USA. Other film credits include lead roles in James Rabbitts' *The Clinic*, and *The Reef*, directed by Andrew Traucki.

Adrienne's television credits include series roles in Network Seven's *All Saints* and *Headland*, and a lead role in Channel Ten's mini-series, *Secrets & Lies*. Her ongoing lead guest roles include *Dr Blake*, and *It's A Date* for ABC 1; *House Husbands*; *Neighbours*; *Home & Away*; *Sea Patrol: Red Gold*; *Mr & Mrs Murder*, and *Out of the Blue*.

Adrienne's theatre credits include *Edmond*, *Romeo and Juliet*, *St Kilda Tales* and *La Ronde*. In 2009, she starred as Zoya in Company B/Belvoir's sell out season of *Ruben Guthrie*, directed by Wayne Blair.

In 2004 Adrienne won the Best Actor award from the Pacific Film and Television Commission – Warner Roadshow Studios, New Filmmakers Awards for her work in the short film *She Was Quiet*.

In 2017 Adrienne filmed the role of Karen Ford in the television series *Ronny Chieng: International Student*

Most recently Adrienne starred as Eileen Bond in the Nine Network's upcoming mini series *House of Bond*, opposite Ben Mingay, Rachael Taylor and Sam Neill.
